Due to our unfailing dedication, this year has proven that Chanco Friends are up to the challenges of the day and are ever so resilient.

And, the moment was not lost on any of us to see the actual high-speed internet service installed. Hooray!

As we move into the new year, we remain focused on three priorities: the understanding of our path forward for our Native American traditions to connect to our mission and values; to navigate our plans effectively and safely to reopen summer camp and retreat activities; and to successfully complete The Campaign for Chanco.

We believe that in the weeks and months ahead, Chanco's restorative ministry will be needed to heal from so much loss. 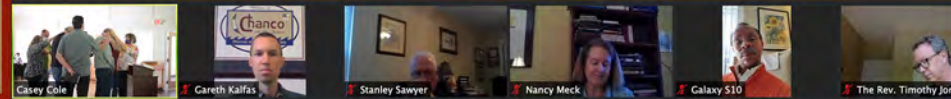

For more than a decade, campers have been saving their change toward an exciting addition to Chanco's camp programs. 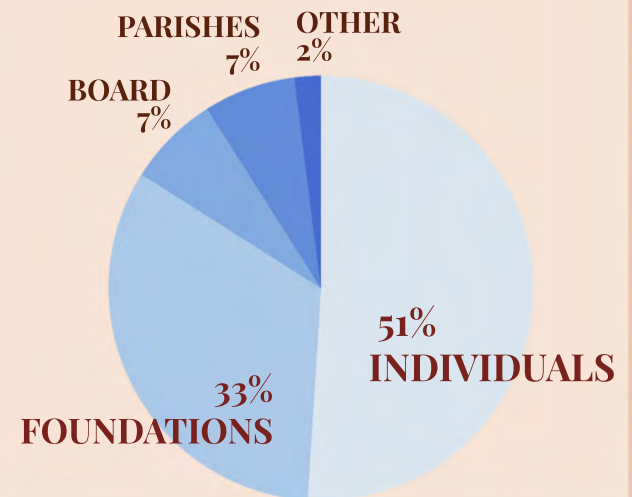

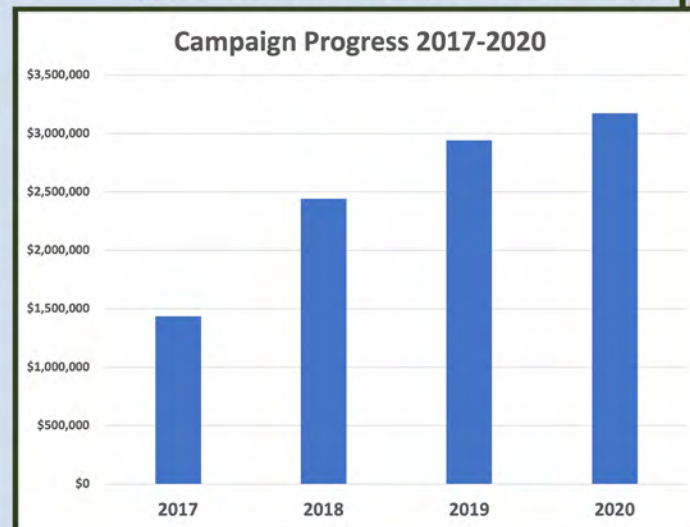
